Aron Maberry was elected to the Clarksville-Montgomery County School Board in August 2022. He is the first ever elected Republican School Board member in Montgomery County. In 2022, Aron was named one of the most influential people under 40 years old in Clarksville by Clarksville Now. Aron is a Leadership CMCSS class of 2022 graduate and will be in the Leadership Clarksville class of 2024.

Aron has a passion for ministry and has served on the staff of Mosaic Church for eight years as the Next-Gen Pastor, overseeing 25 staff members and 800 weekly kids and youth attendees. Aron has lived in Clarksville since elementary school, graduated from Rossview High School, and has a leadership degree from Valor Christian College. Aron has a strong interest in politics and standing up for parents' rights in their children's education. He aims to bring conservative values to the school board.

"On Wednesday, July 19, 2023, Tina Englen, President of the Montgomery County Republican Women's Club, Clarksville, TN, and Ellen Twombly, Literacy Chairman, presented three books to the Montgomery County Public Library. They were received by Christina Riedel, Director for the Clarksville Montgomery County Library.



The books were "Profiles In Corruption" by Peter Schweitzer, "Loserthink" by Scott Adams, and "Marlon Bundo's A Day in the Life of the Vice President " by Charlotte Pence, illus-

trated by Karen Pence. The first book reveals the source of financial support for several prominent politicians. The second book gives insight on how the media and people influence us whether we realize it or not. The extent of truthfulness is not a factor. The last book is a children's book which details a day in the life of a United States Vice President as seen by Bundo, a bunny. It is beautifully illustrated by Karen Pence, a world renowned water color artist, and former Second Lady.

These books will be placed in general circulation in the library. The donated books contain a bookplate crediting the Republican women for the donation."

About MELP

The Mamie Eisenhower Library Project (MELP) is the NFRW's oldest program, celebrating 60 years of book donations from an approved list to schools, libraries, hospitals and other public institutions.

In 1961, the NFRW established the Mamie Eisenhower Library Project as a memorial honoring the former Republican First Lady who served for decades as a military wife and prepared the family home for over 30 moves during President Eisenhower's military service to our country. Born in Iowa and moving to the South as a child, Mrs. Eisenhower was active in financial decisions in her home and often said that a woman's independence was based upon her own ability to save money. She practiced fiscal responsibility as a First Lady, often clipping recipes for the White House Chef to prepare using boxed cake mixes as they were cheaper than baking from scratch.

Each biennium, the NFRW Literacy and Education Committee compiles a list of books that reflect Republican conservative beliefs of self-reliance, freedom and independence. In 1992, tapes and videos were added to the list. In 2020, DVDs and streaming services were added to the list. These books, both adult and children's levels, are intended to be donated to public libraries, all schools, and hospitals to provide reading material to a wide variety of children and adults in our communities. During the COVID-19 pandemic, many clubs expanded to reading children's books online through social media to a nation's children not able to enter school buildings.

Club participation in the Mamie Eisenhower Library Project is one of the requirements for receiving the NFRW Achievement Awards, which are given out at NFRW's biennial convention. <u>https://www.nfrw.org/</u> <u>melp</u>
